IMO 2020

The International Maritime Organization (IMO) has mandated a global 0.50 per cent cap on the maximum level of sulphur in marine fuel down from the current 3.50 per cent limit. Starting on Jan. 1, 2020, vessel operators will need to use a compliant fuel, or have a scrubber fitted if they wish to continue burning high-sulphur fuel oil. This ruling does not affect Emission Control Areas (ECAs), where a 0.10 per cent sulphur fuel cap will still be required.

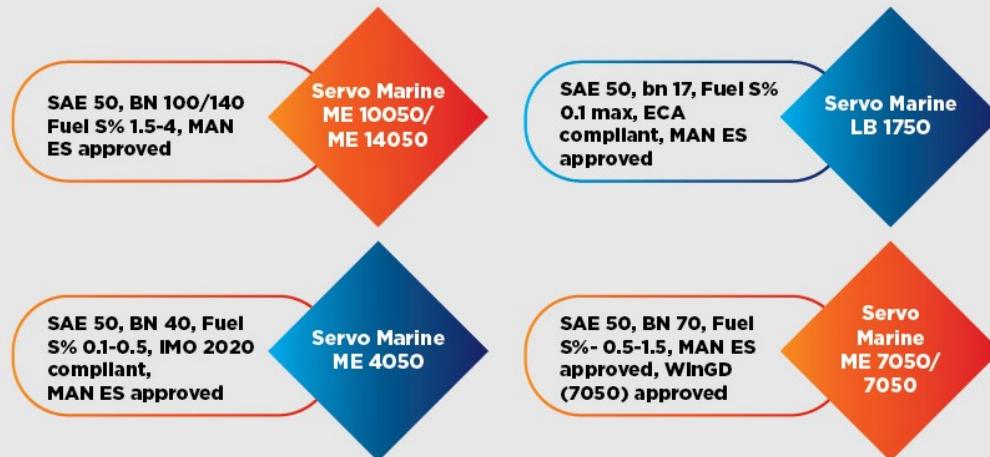

Marine Lubricants

In preparation for the 0.50% S fuel era, it is necessary to update the lubrication guideline for Marine engines. This guideline aims at facilitating lubrication of engines operating on 0.50% S very low sulphur fuel oils (VLSFO), and 0.10% S ultra-low sulphur fuel oils (ULSFO).

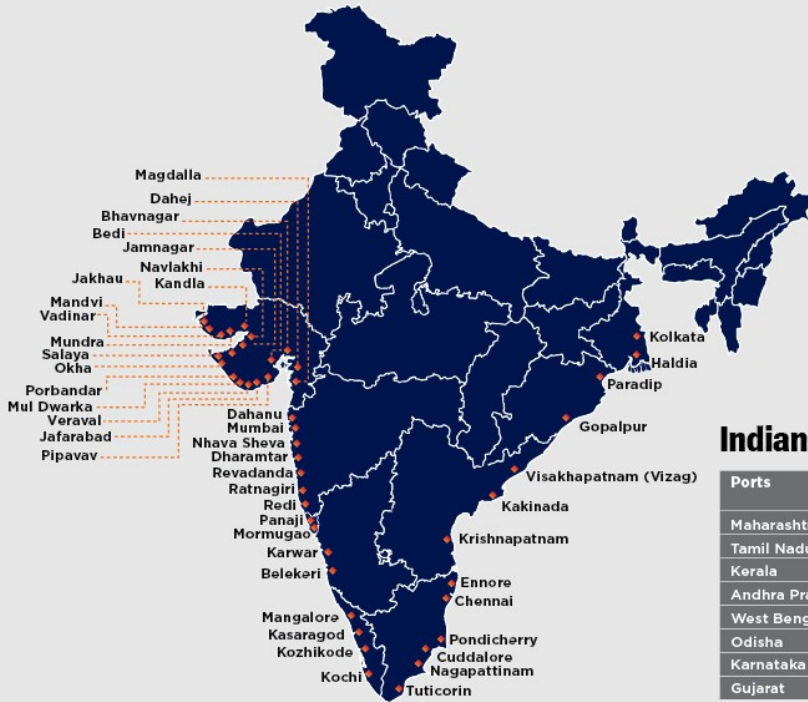
