The posts at Sl 2 to 4 are also suitable for persons with disabilities (PWD) i.e. posts at Sl No 2 & 3 are suitable for PWD in OH category with disability of **hunchback/deformity of chest** and post at Sl No 4 is suitable for PWD in OH & HH category with disability of **one arm partially affected/deformity of chest / partially deaf**. However, such PWD candidates will be considered for selection by general standards of merit.

### **CONCESSION & RELAXATION:**

1. Upper age relaxation of 5 years to SC candidates for the post reserved for them. Upper age relaxation of 10 years for Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates. Age relaxation for Ex-servicemen as per rules.
2. SC/ST/PWD candidates are exempted from payment of application fee.
3. SC/ST candidates called for test/interview will be reimbursed single 2nd class railway fare limited to rail fare from the nearest railway station of the mailing address to the place of test/interview and back by the shortest route, on production of bus ticket/rail ticket provided the distance is not less than 30 kms. each side.

## **SELECTION METHODOLOGY:**

The selection methodology will comprise Written Test, Trade test and Personal Interview of short listed candidates. The candidates will have to pass through each stage including medical fitness successfully for being adjudged as suitable for selection.

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Candidates are advised to carefully read the full advertisement for details of eligibility criteria before submission of application.
2. Service is transferable to anywhere in India.
3. Candidates employed in Government/Semi government/Public Sector Organization must send their application through proper channel or produce "No Objection Certificate" at the time of appearing in the Test/Interview. In case the candidate fails to do so, his/her candidature will not be considered.
4. SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates applying against un-reserved posts shall be considered under general standards and no relaxation in age etc. shall be extended to them.
5. Candidates should apply in the prescribed format only (**DOWNLOAD APPLICATION FORM**) along with application fee, attested copies of mark sheets, educational qualification certificates, caste certificate, Discharge certificate (for EXSM) and a recent passport size colored photograph affixed on the application form.
6. Incomplete applications or applications received after the due date will not be considered.
7. SC/ST/PWD candidates should submit their caste/disability Certificate (for PWD- minimum disability 40%) issued by Competent Authority in the prescribed format along with the application form, in support of their claim to avail relaxation/concession.
8. Application of a candidate having higher qualification than the prescribed qualification shall be rejected.
9. The candidates will have the option to appear for test/interview either in Hindi or English.
10. Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidature.
11. A candidate should apply for one discipline only. Candidates appearing in more than one discipline will not be considered.
