Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. F1(70)Rev/  
8/88 dated 17.1.89 on the above mentioned subject seeking  
prior approval of the Central Government in accordance  
with Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. The proposal has been examined by the Advisory Committee  
constituted by the Central Government under Section 3 of  
the aforesaid Act.

3. After careful consideration of the proposal of the  
State Government and on the basis of the recommendation  
of the above mentioned Advisory Committee, the Central Govt.  
hereby conveys its approval under Section 2 of the Forest  
(Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 3.126 ha. of  
reserve forest land in Jaipur and Alwar districts for  
laying of Petroleum pipeline from Kandla to Bhatinda  
subject to the following conditions:-

1. The legal status of the forest land will remain  
unchanged.
2. Compensatory afforestation will be raised on 3.14 ha.  
of non-forest land as identified, at the cost of the  
project.
