**Engagement of Apprentices under The Apprentices Act, 1961
in Pipelines Division of Indian Oil Corporation Limited**

Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL), the largest commercial enterprise in India and a Fortune “Global 500” Company, as a measure of Skill Building Initiative for the Nation, proposes to engage Apprentices in Technical and Non-Technical Trades at its locations in Pipelines Division.

Applications are invited from eligible Indian Nationals meeting the following qualification & other parameters for engagement of 394 Apprentices under The Apprentices Act, 1961 (as amended from time to time) in the locations as mentioned below:

Note:

1. Candidate should have already passed the prescribed qualification on the date of reckoning eligibility criteria/cut off which is **31.01.2026**.
2. Candidates whose result of the qualifying examination is awaited on the date of reckoning eligibility criteria/cut off are not eligible to apply.
3. The prescribed qualification for Graduate/Diploma holders shall be from a recognized University/Institute as a regular full-time course in the relevant trade/discipline with a minimum of 50% marks (45% for SC/ST and PwBD category candidates for the posts reserved for them) in aggregate.
4. Candidates holding a qualification acquired through part-time/correspondence/distance education mode are not eligible.
5. Candidates possessing higher professional qualifications such as BE/B.Tech., MBA, CA, LLB, MCA, or any such equivalent qualification or pursuing higher qualification and having completed the same on or before joining apprenticeship training, shall not be eligible.

C). AGE CRITERIA

Minimum 18 years and maximum 24 years as on **31.01.2026** which is the date for reckoning any eligibility criteria.

D). DURATION OF APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING

12 months from the date of engagement.

E). STIPEND

Rate of stipend payable to apprentices per month shall be as prescribed under Apprentices Act, 1961/1973, The Apprenticeship Rules, 1992 read with The Apprenticeship (Amendment) Rules, 2019 & 2025 as amended from time to time and Corporation's guidelines.

F). CONCESSIONS & RELAXATIONS

1. Reservation of seats to SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer-NCL)/PwBD/Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates shall be as per the applicable Govt. guidelines.
2. Relaxation in upper age up to 5 years to SC/ST candidates and 3 years to OBC (NCL) candidates considered against reserved positions will be allowed.
3. Relaxation in upper age up to 10 years for PwBD candidates will be allowed irrespective of reservation of posts to them. Further, upper age relaxation of 5 years to PwBD candidates belonging to SC/ST category and 3 years to PwBD-OBC(NCL) candidates will be allowed.
4. The minimum prescribed qualification marks will be relaxed by 5% for candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwBD categories considered against reserved positions.
5. In case of candidates belonging to OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) category, name of OBC caste mentioned in the certificate should fall in the Central List of OBCs of the respective State and Non-Creamy Layer status should be valid as on cut-off date of reckoning eligibility criteria.

G). SELECTION METHODOLOGY

1. Candidates registered in the NAPS/NATS Portal and applying against the notification shall be considered for selection as detailed below:
 - a) Panel cum Merit List of all the candidates, who have applied against a respective post in the portal and meeting the notified eligibility criteria, shall be prepared based on the percentage of marks in descending order (aggregate of marks of all subjects of all years/semesters will be considered for eligibility) obtained in the essential qualification applicable to the trade applied for.

Wherever CGPA/OGPA or Letter Grade is awarded in the ITI (Fitter)/Degree/Diploma examinations, its equivalent aggregate percentage of marks must be indicated by the candidates in the On-line Application as per the norms adopted by Board/University/Institute. Candidates will have to upload certificate from the concerned Board/University/Institute regarding the equivalent aggregate percentage of marks with reference to their CGPA/OGPA or Letter Grade and produce the same at the time of document verification failing which their candidature will not be considered.

In case the Board/Institute/University does not follow any conversion formula for converting CGPA/OGPA to Percentage, candidate will have to produce a certificate to this effect that the Board/Institute/University does not follow any conversion formula and in order to arrive at equivalent percentage of marks, aggregate of Grade score obtained in each semester/year as applicable, divided by the total number of semesters/years will be considered.

In case of Letter Grade, candidate will have to necessarily produce Certificate from the Board/ University/Institute specifying clearly equivalent percentage of marks against Letter Grade failing which their candidature will not be considered.

- b) In case of a similar rank in merit based on the percentage of marks obtained in the essential qualifying examination, a candidate with an earlier date of birth (older in age) shall be considered. In case of same date of birth, candidates having a higher percentage of marks in Matriculation shall be considered.
 - c) There shall be No Written Test or Personal Interview.
2. In case a reserved seat remains unfilled, the same shall be reallocated in the following order of priority: first to SC, then to ST, thereafter to OBC, followed by EWS, and finally to UR.
 3. If seats reserved in any trade for the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) cannot be filled from the Economically Weaker Section (EWS), then the seats so lying unfilled may be filled by persons belonging to unreserved category on the basis of position in the Panel cum Merit List.
 4. Candidates are advised to ensure that they are 'Medically Fit' as per IndianOil's pre-engagement medical standard. Candidates are advised to go through the "Guidelines and Criteria for Physical Fitness for Pre-engagement Medical Examination" at <https://plapps.indianoilpipelines.in/> under download section, before they commence the application process. The persons with benchmark disabilities, except for the identified disability, must be within the normal range of all other physical standards.
 5. A Candidate may undergo maximum two apprenticeship training and the second training shall not be in the same trade. There shall be minimum one year gap between two apprenticeship training, provided that the previous training is completed. No gap shall be required in the case of termination of previous apprenticeship training for the failure other than on the part of the apprentice.
 6. Candidates having job experience for a period of one year or more after the attainment of the qualification shall not be eligible to be engaged as Apprentice.
 7. Candidates who have completed five years after acquiring the prescribed qualification as on date of reckoning eligibility criteria shall also not be eligible for engagement as Apprentices.

H). HOW TO APPLY

3. Candidates must complete the application for Openings/Opportunities in respective NATS/NAPS Portal from **28.01.2026 to 10.02.2026**. Before applying against an opportunity, the candidate MUST ensure that their profile (Personal details, Educational details, Category etc.) along with aggregate percentage are appearing correctly in their application. Candidates are required to contact NAPS/NATS Office in case of any corrections.
4. After applying against an opportunity in the respective NAPS/NATS Portal, the candidate must complete their registration/application for apprentice positions in Indian Oil Pipelines portal at <https://plapps.indianoilpipelines.in/>
5. The candidate must use the same e-mail ID and Mobile Number used in respective NAPS/NATS Portal which must be valid for the entire apprenticeship period.
6. There are two steps for Registration process (Part-I & Part-II) in Indian Oil Pipelines portal at <https://plapps.indianoilpipelines.in/>
 - a. In Part-I registration, candidate must fill their basic details like name, category etc. and must create their own password. After successful Part-I registration, system generated registration number is sent to their registered email id/SMS. With this registration number, candidates have to login into the system again with the password generated by them. Candidates are advised to remember registration number and password for future reference/use.

- b. In Part-II registration, candidates must upload their scanned photograph and signature and furnish educational qualification, experience details etc. and submit the same. The candidate should have scanned copy of colour photograph (Size: between 20-50 KB in JPG Format) and signature in black ink (Size: between 10-30 KB in JPG Format) etc. ready before applying on-line. This is the final submission process and after that candidates cannot change the details furnished. Candidates are therefore advised to furnish the details in the portal carefully and check the same before final submission.

7. Candidates are advised to follow the procedure mentioned in above apprentice engagement portal. In case of any difficulty with respect to filling online application, please refer FAQs/How to apply options available in the portal.
 8. The candidate must ascertain the correctness of all information before filling in the Online Application Form and its final submission. The candidate shall be wholly/exclusively responsible for the information provided in their online application form.

I). VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

Verification of the original documents shall be done before joining of the candidate as an Apprentice. The list of candidates provisionally selected for Document Verification and Medical Fitness shall be published on the IOCL website.

The candidate is required to produce all original certificates, testimonials, and mark sheets, along with one passport-size photograph and self-attested photocopies of the relevant certificates and mark sheets, for verification at the specified date, time, and venue. If, during the document verification process, it is found that the candidate does not meet the prescribed eligibility criteria, or has submitted any incorrect, fabricated, or false information/documents, or has suppressed any material facts, the candidature shall be summarily cancelled without any further notice.

The following original documents along with a self-attested copy should be furnished at the time of Document Verification:

- a) Xth Standard/Matriculation certificate/mark sheet issued by the concerned Education Board as proof of Date of Birth. No other document will be accepted for verification of Date of Birth.
- b) Latest Caste certificate by reserved category candidates in the Proforma prescribed by the Govt. and issued by Competent Authority only.
- c) For claiming the benefit of OBC-NCL category, the candidate should submit a latest Caste Certificate (not more than 12 months old from the date of reckoning i.e. **31.01.2026**) in the Proforma prescribed by Govt. of India, which would, among others, specifically mention that the candidate does not belong to the persons/sections (creamy layer) as mentioned in column 3 of the schedule to the Department of Personnel & Training, Government of India OM NO.36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 08.09.1993. Candidates belonging to OBC category but falling in creamy layer are not entitled to OBC reservation benefits. Accordingly, such candidates may choose to apply for the positions provided they meet the age criteria applicable to UR candidates and indicate their category as "UR". Indian Oil Corporation Limited being a Central Public Sector Undertaking, only those communities that are mentioned in the Central List of OBC-NCL approved by Central Government shall be treated as OBC-NCL for the purpose of reservation. Name of OBC caste mentioned in the certificate should fall in the Central List of OBCs of the respective State.
- d) Semester-wise /Year-wise mark sheets of ITI (NCVT/SCVT)/HSC/Graduation/Diploma in Engineering.
- e) Final ITI (NCVT/SCVT) Certificate/HSC/Graduation/Diploma in Engineering issued by the respective Board /Authority/Institute.
- f) Copy of first page of Bank passbook of Aadhaar seeded account, Aadhar Card, PAN Card, cancelled cheque leaf.
- g) Pre-Engagement Medical Fitness Certificate

Offer of Engagement shall be issued to only those candidates whose all documents including medical fitness certificate is found in order.

J). GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Candidates are advised to carefully read the full advertisement for details of Educational Qualification and other eligibility criteria. Last date of Registration in portal is **10.02.2026, 11:59 PM (IST)**. Candidates are requested to apply sufficiently in advance before the closing date.
2. Candidates **MUST** ensure that their profile (Personal Details, Educational Details, Category etc) along with aggregate marks & percentage obtained in the essential qualification are appearing correctly in application. In case of any corrections, candidates are required to contact NAPS/NATS Office.
3. If the application is not submitted in line with the eligibility criteria, terms & conditions, then the application is liable for rejection.
4. Candidates are advised to maintain the same registered e-mail ID and mobile number till the completion of apprenticeship training.
5. Candidates are advised to periodically visit our website <https://www.iocl.com/apprenticeships> as all future correspondence and latest information shall be shared only on our website. 6. Candidates shall be shortlisted for the Panel cum Merit List purely based on the information furnished by them in online portal.
7. Applications/Registration which are incomplete or are received in any other mode/form or not fulfilling the eligibility criteria and/or those received after the last date of submission of application shall not be considered "Eligible" and treated as "Rejected". Canvassing of any kind shall disqualify the candidate.
8. The candidature of the applicant would be provisional and subject to subsequent verification of certificates and testimonials. In case, it is detected at any stage of selection process or thereafter, that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility norms and/or that he/she has furnished any incorrect/doctored/false information/certificate/documents or has suppressed any material fact(s), their candidature will stand cancelled. 9. Engagement of selected candidates is subject to their being declared medically fit as per the requirement of the Corporation. All such engagement will also be subject to all relevant Rules/Policies/Guidelines of the Corporation.
10. The decision of the Management will be final and binding on all candidates on all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, mode of selection, cancellation of the selection process either in part or full, etc. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Caste/Tribe/Disability/EWS certificate is to be produced by reserved category candidates in the format prescribed by the Govt. and issued by Competent Authority before their joining, at the time of document verification, if they get selected for engagement. 14. Candidates can apply for **one Trade Code ONLY**. Candidates applying for more than one Trade Code will not be considered for any post and their applications will be summarily rejected. 15. Candidates, who are pursuing higher qualification on the date of final submission of online application but have acquired/completed the same subsequently at the time of document verification, shall also not be eligible for engagement and shall not be allowed to Join.
