Made-in-India Bullet train set for run from Surat to Vapi in 2027

New Delhi: Now it's official that railways will run B28, the Bullet train being manufactured in India, on the first stretch of the Ahmedabad-Mumbai Bullet train project that is scheduled to be operational in August 2027. The railway ministry informed a parliamentary panel that the national transporter has decided to start the operation on the Surat to Vapi (97 km) section of the corridor using the trainset being manufactured by BEML.

The report of parliamentary standing committee on railways, which was tabled in both Houses of Parliament on Tuesday, mentioned that when it inquired about the updated completion timeline of Mumbai-Ahmedabad High-Speed Rail (MAHSR) project the ministry said, "Bullet train project is a very complex and technology intensive project. The project involves technology transfer and procurement/ supply from Japan and other countries. The development of the E10 series of Shinkansen is underway in Japan; therefore, detailed information regarding the same is not available. However, a decision has been taken to start the operation using B28 (Bharat made Bullet trainset)."

The ministry also informed the panel that tenders for alternative signalling systems (based on ETCS L2) have been awarded and work has commenced. It added that manufacturing of B28 is currently underway at BEML. The ministry said anticipated timelines for the commencement of the project can be ascertained after the completion of all associated works of civil structures, track, electrical, signalling and telecommunication and supply of trainsets.

"However, efforts are underway to start operation using B28 (Bharat made Bullet, 280 kmph) for Surat to Vapi (97km) in Aug 2027," the report said.

Regarding the anticipated cost escalation, major contributing factors and the specific measures being undertaken to prevent cost overruns, the ministry informed the panel that the original estimated cost of the project was Rs 97,636 crore in Dec 2015 and this was based on the feasibility report. Construction was initially planned partly on viaduct and mostly on embankment. Ministry told committee that there has been cost escalation due to factors that were not considered in the feasibility report — taxes and cess (Rs 29,330 crore), utility shifting (Rs 2,625 crore), station approach development (Rs 2,195 crore), power sourcing arrangement (Rs 1,250 crore), indigenous trains and ETCS signalling system (Rs 16,500 crore), ticketing (Rs 283 crore) and statutory charges owing to forest clearances (Rs 400 crore).

UCC is 'most effective answer' to end gender bias in laws: SC

'Inheritance Rights Skewed In Hindu Law Too'

New Delhi: In yet another strong pitch for "one nation one law", Supreme Court on Tuesday said Uniform Civil Code (UCC) is the most effective tool to remove the prevailing discrimination of women in marriage, succession, inheritance and property rights under the Muslim personal law and other customary laws.

This statement — "most effective answer is UCC" — came from a bench of CJI Surya Kant and Justices R Mahadevan and Joyymalya Bagchi after advocate Prashant Bhushan said inferior inheritance rights given to women under the Muslim Personal Law (Shariat) Application Act, 1937, violated their right to equality and non-discrimination, and hence, must be struck down as unconstitutional, like triple talaq.

Appearing for PIL petitioner Poulomi P Shukla, Bhushan said it is inconceivable that Muslim women in Uttarakhnad, which has enacted UCC, would enjoy equal property inheritance rights with their male siblings, but Muslim women in Delhi or other states in India would be deprived of the same.

The bench said inequality in inheritance rights of women compared to their male siblings are present even in

ational (and subsequently banned by a Parliament enacted legislation). But the grounds of divorce in Muslim marriage remain asymmetrical. The right to dissolution of marriage by Muslim women continues to be limited under the 1937 Act. But a Muslim man has much wider grounds to give divorce," Justice Bagchi said. CJI Kant said, "The most effective answer, as articulated by Justice Bagchi, is UCC."

Bhushan said till then, should Muslim women continue to suffer violation of their Article 14 right to equality in inheritance. Justice Bagchi said, "Many such discriminations are there." On polygamy, Justice Bagchi said, "(Has) monogamous marriage, been achieved throughout the country? Can we declare all bigamous or polygamous marriages under personal laws to be unconstitutional as it violates the right to equality?" The bench said, "All these have to appeal to the conscience of the legislature to bring into reality the object of Article 44 in Directive Principles of State Policy chapter of the Constitution."

SC bail for dad of Porsche car crash accused

New Delhi: Supreme Court on Tuesday granted bail to the father of the minor who was alleged to be driving a Porsche car involved in an accident in Pune last year that left two young software engineers dead.

He is accused of tampering with evidence by swapping the blood sample of his son who was allegedly behind the wheel on that fateful night. A bench of Justices BV Nagarathna and Ujjal Bhuyan granted the father relief after noting that other accused in the case have been granted bail.

Proceedings in the case have got prolonged as the petitioner as well as Centre sought adjournments and also because court could not spare time for it owing to heavy caseload. The activist was taken under preventive detention on Sep 26.

at around 2:30 am on May 19, 2024, when the Porsche car, allegedly driven by the juvenile in an inebriated state, rammed into a motorcycle in Pune's Kalyani Nagar area. The crash killed 24-year-old software engineers Anesh Awadhya and Ashwini Koshta, both were from Madhya Pradesh.

Dead Olive Ridleys on Odisha coast drive tourists away

Kendrapada: Around 1,500 carcasses of Olive Ridley sea turtles recently washed ashore along a 25km stretch from the Jatadhari river mouth in Odisha's Jagatsinghpur district to Eakakula beach within Gahirmatha marine sanctuary in Kendrapada district, which is the world's largest rookery of these species of sea turtles.

"The turtles got entangled in the trawlers' fishing nets and died," Kapilendra Pradhan, forest range officer of Gahirmatha sanctuary said. "Many carcasses bear injury marks, suggesting they were trapped either in trawl or gill nets," Hemant Rout, secretary of Gahirmatha Marine Turtles and Mangrove Conservation Society said.

Odisha govt had imposed a fishing ban inside Gahirmatha sanctuary — about 20 km off the coast — from Nov 1 to May 31 to protect the turtles. Forest teams also carried out surprise raids to prevent fishing in the prohibited zone. Kapilendra said the nets

were found outside the sanctuary's limits, where fishing was not prohibited. "However, strong winds push the carcasses ashore along Gahirmatha coast. We bury the dead turtles near the beach to prevent pollution," he said.

The sight and stench of dead turtles began to drive visitors away from Siali, Satabhaya, Penha and Paradip beaches in Kendrapada and Jagatsinghpur districts, affecting local shopkeepers and hotel owners dependent on tourist footfall. "The stench has dashed our hopes as tourists avoid the area," Anam Behera, a tea stall owner at Paradip beach, said.

In a barehand battle, boy (18) kills leopard in HP village

Shimla: With raw courage and bare hands, an ITI student (18) fought off and killed a leopard after being attacked in Himachal Pradesh's Solan, reports Sanjeev Verma.

The three-year-old leopard pounced on Parvish Sharma when he was out to fetch milk around 7am Monday. The youngster grappled with the predator, kept its teeth away from his neck, and clobbered it on the head with every rock and stone he could lay his hands on until the leopard died.

Parvish, in the second year of an electrician course, lives in Sarli village, some 60km from Shimla. He was barely 25 metres from his home when he saw from the corner of his eyes what looked like a blue leopard at him.

In a spur of sheer terror, the teenager didn't panic. TNN

Parl Nod Sought for ₹2.81 L cr Extra Spending

Additional transfer to Stabilisation Fund to cushion economy against unrest caused by war

Our Bureau

New Delhi: The government on Tuesday sought parliamentary approval for gross additional expenditure of ₹2.81 lakh crore for this fiscal year, including higher allocation for fertilisers and food subsidy, defence services, sovereign gold bond, and additional transfer to Economic Stabilisation Fund aimed at cushioning the economy against global volatility especially the turmoil caused by the Iran war.

The second batch of supplementary demand for grants, tabled by finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman in the Lok Sabha, include a net cash outflow of ₹2.01 lakh crore, while ₹80,145.71 crore of the spending will be met through savings of ministries and departments or through enhanced receipts and recoveries, according to the document.

Officials ruled out any possibility of fiscal slippage. "At this stage we are comfortable yet cautious, with enough headroom to absorb any external shock," a senior official told ET, adding that the Centre is closely watching the situation and "will take additional measures if the war escalates further".

Experts played down any significant impact on the fiscal deficit, given that a large part of it will be met by savings across ministries.

"We do not expect a material fiscal slippage on this account," said Aditi Nayar, chief economist, Ica. "Although the net cash outflow under the second supplementary demand for grants has been pegged at a sizeable ₹2.0 trillion, this is likely to be offset to a large extent by expenditure savings across ministries."

The Centre has cut total expenditure to ₹49.65 lakh crore in the Revised Estimates for FY26, from ₹50.65 lakh crore. The latest Controller General of Accounts (CGA) data says the government had spent ₹36.90 lakh crore during April till January. ET reported on February 5 that lower-than-projected fund utilisations by more than a dozen and a half ministries including drinking water and sanitation, housing and urban affairs, and telecommunications are estimated to have resulted in savings of about ₹1.94 lakh crore in the FY26 revised estimates from the budgeted level.

Explaining further, Nayar said the Centre's revenue expenditure needs to expand by as much as 30% year-on-year during February-March 2026 to meet the revised estimates, entailing an incremental amount of ₹2.3 lakh crore.

The additional spending package includes ₹23,641 crore for food subsidy under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana, aimed at supporting free foodgrain distribution to eligible households.

Road and Rail Projects Worth ₹11,944 cr Cleared by Cabinet

11-km long elevated road project on Jewar airport-Faridabad section gets approval

New Delhi: The Union Cabinet on Tuesday approved road and railway infrastructure projects worth ₹11,944 crore. These include the development of an 80.45-km four-lane corridor in Madhya Pradesh at an investment of ₹3,839.42 crore. It also cleared an 11-km elevated road project on the Jewar airport-Faridabad section, which will cost ₹689.24 crore, taking the total cost of the project to ₹3,630.77 crore.

Roadway projects approved include the fourth line between Sainthia and Pakur, and between Santragachi and Kharagpur. These projects cover five districts across West Bengal and Jharkhand and will expand the existing Indian Railways network by about 192 km.

An official statement said the railway projects are key routes for transporting commodities such as coal, stone, dolomite, cement, slag, gypsum, iron and steel, foodgrains, petroleum products and containers. The capacity augmentation is expected to enable an additional freight movement of about 31 million tonnes per annum.

Greenfield road connectivity between the DND-Balabhagh Bypass and Jewar International Airport will link the airport to the Delhi-Mumbai Expressway, another statement said. The Haryana government has agreed to bear ₹150 crore of the additional cost for the elevated corridor, considered a critical segment.

The 80-km corridor in Madhya Pradesh, to be developed on NH-752D, will extend from Badnawar to Timarwani and provide connectivity from Ujjain to the Timarwani interchange on the Delhi-Mumbai Expressway. The proposed four-lane corridor will be built under the hybrid annuity mode (HAM) with a concession period of 17 years, including a two-year construction period.

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Parliament Watch

Indigenous Bullet Trainset Planned for 2027: Ministry

India plans to use its domestically manufactured Bullet Trainset at the Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Corridor from Surat to Vapi (97 km) in Aug 2027, the Centre has informed the parliamentary standing committee on railways. Manufacturing of the B28 trainset, capable of running at 280 kmph is currently underway at BEML. The development of E10 series of Shinkansen is underway in Japan, the Railway Ministry said. Anticipated timelines for the commencement of the full project can be reasonably ascertained after the completion of all associated works of civil structures, track, electrical, signalling & telecommunication and supply of trainsets, the railway said.

RBI Examining Complaints Against Standard Chartered

The finance ministry informed the Rajya Sabha that the RBI has received a reference on complaints against Standard Chartered Bank for instances of repeated collusive asset disposal of several builders at discounted value. MoS for finance Pankaj Chaudhary informed that the Supervisory Evaluation Division (SED) for the bank, RBI had received a reference in October 2024 and February 2026.
