- IndianOil also has 65% market share in the aviation fuel business, refuelling about 1,500 aircraft a day.
- To cater to the rural areas, IndianOil has launched Kisan Seva Kendra outlets, which act
 as one-stop shops for petroleum fuels as well as hybrid seeds, fertilisers, pesticides, farm
 implements and other daily necessities. This network has expanded beyond 5,000 as on
 date.
- IndianOil offers a full slate of petrochemical products under the brand name PROPEL.
- A more recent entrant into IndianOil's brand armoury is *Autogas*; the brand, available at nearly 400 stations, is already a leader in the auto-LPG segment.
- With over 5 lakh cards in circulation, IndianOil's XTRAPOWER fleet card is one of the largest loyalty programmes in the country.

- It also operates a facility for receipt, storage and delivery of Aviation Fuel to the aircraft operating from THOISE [Transit Halt Of Indian Soldiers Enroute (to Siachen)] air base of the Indian Air Force located in Shyok Valley of the Himalayas in Jammu and Kashmir.
