

Pipelines: Underground Highways

- Pipelines Network spanning 11,214 Km across India.
- Mathura-Delhi Pipeline the first pipeline to introduce BS-IV compliant petrol to Delhi /NCR
- Chennai-Bengaluru product pipeline commissioned
- CTMPL achieves ZERO incident and pilferage record consecutively for the 5th year
- TPM implementation underway in Mathura – Delhi Pipeline
- Capacity of Mundra-Panipat pipeline augmented from 6 to 9 MMTPA in June 2010
- Capacity of Chennai-Trichy-Madurai pipeline augmented from 1.8 to 2.3 MMTPA
- The Corporation's pipelines continued to deliver significant performance and achieved a throughput of 74.20 million tonnes during the year as against 75.50 million tonnes last year.
- The Corporation during the year set up a crude blending facility in Vadinar and is augmenting the capacity of its 2 major pipelines to carry higher viscosity crude.
- Presently, its Paradip Haldia Durgapur LPG pipeline project is under implementation.
