Glorious moments in Sports

- Received Silver medal from the Prime Minister of Malaysia in the 1998 commonwealth games at Kuala Lumpur.
- Won two gold and one silver Medal in South Asian Federation games (SAF games) in Pakistan in 2004
- Won Bronze Medal in Men doubles in the French Open Badminton Championships held in Paris 2001.
- Sports Excellence award from Finance Minister, Govt of India in 1998 and the G V Raja award from the Kerala Govt as the best sportsman of Kerala in 2000
- Represented India in Thomas Cup Asian Zone and the team reached the Thomas cup world team championships finals in 2000 and 2006.
- Winner of Asian Satellite championships at Pakistan, Sri Lanka
- Represented India in All England Championships, Singapore Open, Malaysia Open, Indonesia Open
- Reached the finals of the National Championships in Men Doubles (4 times) and Mixed Doubles (3 times) and won 3 titles in Men Doubles and 2 titles in Mixed Doubles. Besides, won Gold Medals in various National Games.
- Won many titles in the Petroleum Sports Promotion Board tournaments (1993-2004).
