- The above mentioned Pay Scales are due for revision and the posts carry other allowances/ benefits as admissible under the rules of the Corporation.
- The prescribed period of Apprenticeship training under Apprentices (Amendment) Act 1973 in the relevant discipline if completed successfully shall be treated as experience.
- AGE LIMIT: Minimum 18 years and maximum 32 years as on 31/07/2010. For PH candidate's age is relaxable by 10 years for General candidates (Relaxable by 15 years for SC, ST and 13 years for OBC candidates). Age relaxation for Ex-Servicemen is applicable as per rules.
- Eligible candidates appearing for written test/interview shall be reimbursed second-class rail/bus fare by the shortest route as per rules on production of tickets.
- Applicants from Govt./Semi Govt./PSU must apply through proper channel or produce "No objection certificate" at the time of appearing in the written test /interview.
- Applications without supporting documents/incomplete/not fulfilling the prescribed criteria in any respect are liable to be rejected.
- The period of experience/qualification will be determined as on 31/07/2010. In case of non-availability of suitable experienced candidates, experience may be relaxed at the discretion of the management.
